2015 DAVE AND DAN CLASSIC RAISES \$757,837 FOR CHILDREN'S MIRCACLE NETWORK HOSPITALS

BEAVERTON, Ore., and MOUNTAIN VIEW, Calif. – August 10, 2015 – <u>First Tech Federal Credit Union</u> and a consortium of credit unions, corporate sponsors, credit union members and celebrities came together to raise \$757,837 in support of Credit Unions for Kids (CU4K), benefitting Children's Miracle Network (CMN) Hospitals.

Fundraising efforts culminated on July 13 with the 3rd Annual <u>Dave & Dan Classic</u> shattering last year's record. "It's heartwarming to see the credit union community band together to support our local children's hospitals and help ensure that every child receives the future they deserve," stated Greg Mitchell, First Tech president and CEO.
